In this MA application, the applicant has prayed for condonation of delay of 3 years and 10 days in filing the original application no. OA-415 of 2019. The ground stated for delay in response to her application given by the respondent to her representations. The application for compassionate employment was submitted on 13.08.2001 which Mrs. Agarwal states that till date state respondents has not disposed of application.

Since no response was forth coming, the applicant finally decided to approach the Tribunal seeking suitable directions to the respondents through this OA-415 of 2019.

Mr. Banerjee submits that the MA is not maintainable as per the Section 21 of the Administrative Tribunal's Act 1985 as no specific grounds has been shown by the applicant which causes such delay.

The counsel for the applicant submits that since the applicant having submitted an application for compassionate employment and waiting response from the respondents as a needy family, delay in filing the original application may be condoned and the MA be allowed.
