The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of counsel for both the parties, matter has been taken up.

Today, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that he has challenged the suspension order as well as prayed for arrear of subsistence allowance till the date of revocation of suspension order.

As per the applicant, during the pendency of the instant MA & OA, the respondent authority has revoked the suspension order w.e.f. 26.04.2021 vide order dated 27.04.2021. Therefore, counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice the purpose of the applicant if the authority would be directed to release the arrear subsistence allowance within a stipulated period of time.

The counsel for the respondent has also admitted that the suspension order has been revoked by order dated 27.04.2021. However, he has no knowledge about the payment of arrear of subsistence allowance, if any.

Heard the parties and perused the records. Let the copy of the revocation of suspension order dated 27.04.2022 be kept with the record.

In view of the above, the respondents are directed to make payment of arrear of subsistence allowance, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the order to the applicant.
