This application, being MA-71 of 2021, in connection with OA-356 of 2010 has been filed praying for "to decide the matter afresh in accordance with law in pursuance of the order dated 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2012 passed in W.P.S.T. No. 76 of 2012, by the Hon'ble High court at Calcutta and pass such other or further other order or orders as Your Lordships may deem fit and proper;"

Mr.B.L.Sahoo, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the applicant submits that in view of the order dated 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2012 passed in W.P.S.T. No. 76 of 2012 (Samir Chakraborty and Others Vs. State of West Bengal and Others), the Original application be heard afresh.

Mr.S.Bhattacharjee, learned advocate submits that Mr.A.L.Basu, learned advocate, who had appeared for the State respondents earlier does not have the brief of the Original application. Moreover due to pandemic, he is not appearing in Court.

We find that on 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2012 while disposing of W.P.S.T. No. 76 of 2012, the High Court had passed an order, the relevant portion of which is as under:

taken a view that a single member of the West Bengal State Administrative Tribunal has no jurisdiction to decide an original application. It must be decided by a bench of two members, one of whom must be a judicial member.

In these circumstances, the impugned order, which has been passed by a single member, is set aside and the matter is remanded to the Tribunal to decide it afresh in accordance with law."

In view of the order passed by the High Court, let the Original application being OA-356 of 2010 appear under the heading "For Order" on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2022.

The Miscellaneous application being MA-71 of 2021 is disposed of.

Let a copy of the Original application along with reply and rejoinder be served on the respondent nos. 2 (2) and 2 (3) along with a copy of this order downloaded from the website of the Tribunal by 18<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 and affidavit of service be affirmed and filed on the next date of hearing.
