The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No.638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The applicant, being wife of the deceased employee, has prayed for a direction upon the respondent authorities to give her appointment on compassionate ground due to death of her husband, Debasish Ghosh on 22.01.2019.

The applicant made an application on 13.02.2020 on plain paper to the Superintendent of Police (SS Head Quarters), Crime Investigation Department. An enquiry was held and its report was placed before the Superintendent of Police, CID, West Bengal on 05.04.2019. The report was related to the legal heirs of the deceased employee. The applicant continued to pray for her appointment and submitted one more representation before the Superintendent of Police, CID, West Bengal on 06.11.2023.

Submission of Mr. Nandi is that despite being eligible and submitting several representations before the respondent authorities, the authorities are sitting tight over the matter and had not taken any decision till date.

Having heard the submissions of the learned counsels and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this application is disposed of by directing the respondent No.1, the Additional Chief Secretary, Home & Hill Affairs Department
