Counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant is a 77 (seventy seven) years old lady and is praying for family pension on behalf of her deceased husband. According to the applicant, her husband retired on 30.06.1990, thereafter he was getting pension. However, he died on 12.11.2020. Thereafter the applicant approached the authority for family pension. But till date she has not been paid any family pension.

Counsel for the respondent has drawn our attention to the three names of the same lady and she has also submitted representation before the authority dated 20.02.2020 where no signature and/or L.T.I. of the applicant is available.

During the course of hearing, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant wants to file a detail representation before the authority, Commissioner of Commercial Taxes, Respondent No. 2. Counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice his purpose if the authority would consider her representation and take action accordingly. The counsel for the respondent has no objection if any appropriate representation would be made before the authority as per rules.

Heard the parties and perused the records.

In view of the above, the applicant is at liberty to make representation before the authority within fifteen days from the date of receipt of the order. In the event, the applicant would file detail Form No.
