The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No.638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The applicant appears in person.

This application has been filed praying for a direction to the concerned respondent authority to appoint her in any post under the compassionate employment scheme. The applicant has appeared in person and from her statements and the records, it appears that after death of her father, Swarup Kumar Mitra, she had submitted her application for such employment. Since no response was shown from the side of the respondents, the applicant had filed an application before this Tribunal. The Tribunal passed a direction on 28.11.2018 in O.A. No.725 of 2018 directing the respondents to consider and pass a speaking and reasoned order.

The applicant submits that despite the Tribunal's direction, no reasoned order has been passed, however, she admits that by a correspondence dated 27.01.2023 she was asked to appear before the Reserve Office, Port Division, Kolkata. She complied with such advice and had attended the Reserved Office. Despite several follow ups her case has not been considered, and prays for a direction to the Form No.

respondent authorities to consider her application for compassionate employment.

Appearing on behalf of the State respondents, Mr. Manujendra Narayan Roy, learned counsel submits that if such a direction is passed to consider her application, the same will be complied as per law.

Having heard the learned counsel for the State respondents and the applicant in person, this case is disposed of by directing the respondent No.2 (iv), the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Port Division, Kolkata to consider her application for employment on compassionate ground, as such a direction was also given by this Tribunal in O.A. 725 of 2018 dated 28.11.2018, by passing a reasoned order as per law within eight weeks from the date of communication of this order.

The application is disposed of.
