The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the Notification No. 949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24.12.2020 issued in exercise of the power conferred under Sub-Section (6) of Section 5 of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985.

The instant application has been filed praying for a direction upon the respondent to consider the case of the applicant for compassionate appointment. As per the applicant, his mother died on 24.05.2012 and subsequently he made an application for compassionate appointment and vide Memo dated 27.01.2016, Medical Superintendent-cum-Vice Principal, Burdwan Medical College & Hospital had forwarded the original proforma application along with other relevant documents including enquiry report to the Director of Health Services, West Bengal for taking appropriate steps. However, till date no final decision has been communicated to the applicant.

During the course of hearing, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice the purpose of the applicant if the Principal Secretary, Health & Family Welfare Department would be directed to take final decision and communicate the same within a stipulated period of time.

None appears for the respondent for a long time. No reply has also been filed.
