The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

Mrs. S. Mitra, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent submits that the applicant's husband was a work charged employee and had served only 7 (seven) years 1 (one) month and 22 (twenty two) days, therefore, he was not entitled for pension. Thus, the question of family pension to the applicant does not arise. It is also submitted that since this is a pension matter, the Principal Accountant General (A & E), W.B. has not been added as a party.

Learned counsel for the applicant prays for adjournment. Learned counsel for the applicant also prays for liberty to Principal Accountant General (A & E), W.B. as a party. The question of admissibility of this application be kept open.
