The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638 - WBAT / 2J-15/2016 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Affidavit of service filed be kept in record.

The applicant has prayed for a direction upon the respondent authorities to disburse the family pension and other benefits arising out of deceased employee, Ashoke Kumar Roy. Ashoke Kumar Roy was an employee under the Tourism Directorate and died on 25.04.2009. Apart from this applicant, claiming to be the wife of the deceased employee, other legal heirs are including Smt. Alo Roy (second wife), Rubi Roy and Biswajit Roy, children of the deceased employee with Alo Roy, Amar Nath Roy and Aloke Nath Roy, children of the deceased from Minati Roy.

Mr. Bhattacharjee, learned counsel draws attention to copies of an order passed on 27.07.2011. The Deputy Secretary in this order completes the hearing by concluding that Minati Roy, legal wife of the deceased Ashoke Kumar Roy is entitled to get the admissible family pension with full share. Submission is, despite such clear indication in the order, the respondent authority has not released the family pension and other admissible benefits to the applicant.

Since there appears to be a clearly worded reasoned order as cited above and since such benefit as per the order have not been disbursed so far, the Tribunal directs the respondent No. 3, Director of Tourism to examine the entire matter, and if it is found that such benefits have not been released to the legal heirs, steps may be taken to do so without loss of further time and preferably within 90 (ninety) days from the date this order is communicated to him.

This application is disposed of.
