The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of counsel of both the parties, matter has been taken up.

The instant application has been filed praying for enhancement of remuneration as per circular dated 16.09.2011, 25.02.2016 and 15.07.2019.

The counsel for the respondent has raised preliminary objection on the ground that the applicant without approaching the authority has straightway come to this Court. Further as per Circular dated 20.05.2009 as well as 27.11.2017 of Finance Department, the part time casual labourers are not entitled to get the enhanced remuneration exceeding Rs. 3,000/- per month.

However, during the course of hearing, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice his purpose if the authority would be directed to treat this OA as his representation and pass a reasoned and speaking order within a stipulated period of time.
