The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of counsel for both the parties, matter has been taken up.

During the course of hearing, the counsel for the applicant has prayed for leave to add one prayer as prayer 10 (d) praying for a direction to regularise the absent period, if any, of her husband and to allow her to make an application on behalf of her husband. It has been further submitted by the counsel for the applicant that inadvertently, Office of the A.G.W.B. has not been made party, though it is a case of family pension and pensionary benefits.

Prayers are allowed. The counsel for the applicant is directed to make appropriate amendments in the Court's file and the respondent's file and to serve a copy of the application to the Departmental Representative of A.G.W.B. also.
