The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The prayer of the applicant is for a direction to the respondent to expedite her application for compassionate employment for the post of Group-D. The father of the applicant was a "Tyreman" in Kolkata Police and died in harness on 11.03.2010. Thereafter, the widow of the deceased employee submitted an application before the respondent praying for compassionate employment on 12.08.2010 before the Joint Commissioner of Police (Headquarters). Later, she submitted another petition requesting the compassionate employment be given to her daughter on 21.10.2014. It appears from a correspondence by Commissioner of Police, Kolkata on 26.09.2016 to the applicant, Rumpa Mondal, intimating that if she is interested for a compassionate employment, then she should submit certain relevant documents. Submission of Mr. Sen is that

a direction be given to the respondent to expedite the process of compassionate employment to the applicant.

Mrs. Mitra appearing on behalf of the state respondent agrees that if a direction be given the same will be complied as per rules.

After hearing the learned counsels, the respondent No. 1, Addl. Chief Secretary, Home & Hill Affairs Department is directed to consider the application of the applicant for compassionate employment as per eligibility and rules and dispose of the same by passing a reasoned order within a period of 12 weeks from the date of communication of this order. The reasoned order, so passed by him, shall also be communicated to the applicant within a period of two weeks thereof.

Accordingly, the matter is disposed of.
