The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated $11^{\text {th }}$ February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of all the parties, matter has been taken up.
Today, the counsel for the respondent has submitted that as per the order of this Tribunal dated 08.02.2022, the department has already paid the interim allowance as well as admissible part of pensionary benefits and has placed the order dated 12.04.2022 passed by the Assistant Accounts Officer, Office of the Principal A.G.(A\&E), W.B. He has further submitted that as one criminal case is still pending, interim allowance as well as admissible amount of pensionary benefits has already been paid.

The counsel for the applicant has also admitted the same.
Since the grievances of the applicant has already been redressed by paying interim allowance and other admissible part of pensionary benefits, therefore, the OA is disposed of as become infructuous.
