The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638 – WBAT / 2J-15/2016 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsel, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The prayer in this application is for release of 3/4<sup>th</sup> share of the death benefits of the deceased employee in favour of the applicants. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has all the authorised documents to prove that she is one of the legal heirs and she deserves to be paid 3/4<sup>th</sup> of the benefits as accrued to her after the death of her husband, Dhiren Chandra Mukhi. Submission is for liberty to be given to the applicant to furnish a fresh application in this regard before the respondent by the applicant. Mr. Banerjee appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that if such a direction is given, the same will be disposed of as per Rules.

After hearing the learned counsels, the application is disposed of by directing the Respondent No. 4 i.e. Medical Superintendent-cum-Vice Principal, Midnapore Medical College & Hospital, Paschim Medinipore to consider and dispose of such a representation, if filed by the applicant within two weeks from today and dispose of the same within a period of twelve weeks thereafter after considering its admissibility and submissions of other legal heirs. Accordingly the matter is disposed of.
