The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 354 - WBAT / 2J-15/2016 dated 18^{th} May, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6(5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The instant application has been filed by one Shri Amit Chakraborty, who has some grievances against the President, Ex-servicemen, Re-settlement Society, Calcutta and Medical Superintendent & Vice-president, IPGME & R, SSKM Hospital as well as Senior Supervision in-charge, IPGME & R, SSKM Hospital. Though none appears for the applicant on 24.02.2022, 07.06.2022 even today, however, one Mr. D. Roy has appeared on behalf of the Respondent No. 2 (i) and has submitted that they are the Ex-servicemen, Re-settlement Society, who under the agreement with the Rajya Sainik Board, Govt. of West Bengal, is the Society for Ex-servicemen for their re-settlement and they help the Rajya Sainik Board, who as per the advice of the Rajya Sainik Board used to provide man-power to the Govt. of West Bengal. The applicant is only being the member of the said Society was engaged with the SSKM Hospital as 'Karmabandhu' which is not a State government employee at all. However, as they are the Society under the Society Registration Act, therefore, this Tribunal does not have jurisdiction over the same. Accordingly, he has prayed for dismissal of the O.A. I have gone through the documents submitted by the Form No.

Respondent No. 2(i) and it seems that Respondent No. 1 is Registered Society of Ex-servicemen, who provides services / man-power with the State of West Bengal as per the advice of the Rajya Sainik Board. Therefore, this Tribunal does not have any jurisdiction over the same.

Heard the counsel and perused the record. As the applicant is not a Government employee at all being a member of the said Association, for which this Tribunal does not have any jurisdiction. Accordingly, the O.A. is dismissed for want of jurisdiction.
