None for the applicant. It is noted that nobody is appearing for the applicant since filing, i.e. on 25.01.2022, However, the counsel for the respondent now has submitted that this Tribunal does not have the jurisdiction over the applicant as the applicant is working under West Bengal Financial Corporation. Therefore, this Tribunal does not have the jurisdiction.

Heard the respondent and perused the record. It is noted that the applicant is the contractual employee of the West Bengal Financial Corporation, who has challenged the show-cause notice dated 23.12.2021, issued by the Deputy General Manager (Administration), West Bengal Financial Corporation. Since the applicant was working as Junior Officer (Contractual) under the West Bengal Financial Corporation, which is an undertaking, therefore, in my opinion, this court does not have the jurisdiction over the same. Accordingly, the O.A. is dismissed for want of jurisdiction. However, the applicant would be at liberty to approach before the appropriate forum in accordance with law.
