Since despite service of notice, none appears on behalf of the State respondents, Mr. G.P. Banerjee, learned advocate who normally appears on behalf of the State authorities, is requested to appear in this matter. Let a copy of the application be furnished on him, which is served and accepted. The Learned Legal Remembrancer, West Bengal is directed to regularise the appointment of Mr. Banerjee.

The matter is admitted. Let reply be filed by 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. Rejoinder, if any, by 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2022.

So far the prayer for interim order is concerned, it is submitted by Sk. J. Hossain, learned advocate for the applicant that since the applicant has been posted as a Librarian in Banarhat Hindi College, Jalpaiguri and he is not proficient in Hindi, the Public Service Commission, West Bengal may be directed to change the place of posting.

Mr. S. Bhattacharjee, learned advocate for the Commission referring to the application form of the applicant, appearing at page 15 of the application, submits since it is evident that the applicant completed his Bachelor of Science (Three Years' Degree Course) from Vinoba Bhave University at Jharkhand and had Hindi as a first subject in that level, no interim order may be passed.

So far as the prayer for interim order is concerned since prima facie it appears the applicant in degree level had Hindi as a "subject taken", no interim order is passed.
