In this application, the prayer is for directing the respondent authorities to consider the application for compassionate appointment. The deceased employee Madhu

Composite Unit, Uttar Dinajpur district who died in harness on 18.11.2012. The widow Somua Pasman made a plain paper application before the respondent authority seeking compassionate employment on 11.09.2016, after a lapse of nearly four years. Thus, application for employment was made on behalf

Pasman was a Resham Karmee working at Hemtabad Sericulture

of her son, Ajay Pasman who at the time of his father's death was a minor of 13 years only. The papers in the record do not appear to show any receipt given by the office of the respondent. Having

not received any response from the respondent, the applicant

approached before the Tribunal on 27.11.2017.

It also appears from the record that on five occasions in the past, the Tribunal had directed the learned advocate representing the state to file reply. Despite this direction, the respondent has failed to submit any reply against the application made before the respondent, despite giving direction "last chance" to file reply by the respondents four years ago.

Since no reply has been filed by the respondents, the

application is disposed of by directing the Respondent No. ii) Commissioner, Textiles & Sericulture to dispose of this application for compassionate employment as per law within a period of eight weeks from the date of this order to be obtained from the website of the Tribunal. The considered order of the respondent should also be communicated to the applicant within a period of two weeks from the date of the respondent's order. Accordingly, the OA is disposed of.
