The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The prayer in this application is for a direction to the respondents to grant him the benefits stipulated under Memo No. 9008-F(P) dated 16.09.2011 and other similar Notifications. The applicant is a Casual /Part-time Worker working under the Office of SDO, Mathabhanga, Coochbehar.

Mr. P. Baidya, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant prays for liberty to file a fresh representation before the Respondent No. 2, SDO, Mathabhanga, Coochbehar for consideration of his prayer.

The Departmental Representatives submit that as a part time worker, the applicant is not entitled for benefits under Memo No. 9008-F(P) Notification since he does not fulfil the required criteria. However, if a direction is given to the respondents, the same will be considered as per Rules.

After hearing the learned counsels, the matter is disposed of by directing the respondent no. 2, SDO, Mathabhanga, Coochbehar to consider a representation, if so filed by the applicant within a period of
