The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 536-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

After hearing both the learned advocates and considering the facts and circumstances, the Court is of the view that the applicant has not been able to establish his case which is in contravention to the impugned order. The respondent had considered the application and a reasoned order was passed rejecting the same on the ground that the applicant was a minor at the time of deceased employee’s death. This decision was in conformity with Notification No. 251 dated 03.12.2013, read with Para No. 10 (aa) of the Notification No. 26-Emp dated 03.03.2016 of the Labour Department. Hence the application is dismissed and the matter is disposed of.
