The applicant, being a legal heir has prayed for a direction to the respondent authorities to release leave salary and other retiral benefits of his deceased father for the period from 14.05.2002 to 31.01.2003. During this period, the deceased employee had worked as Secretary, K. S. Roy T.B. Hospital, Jadavpur. Against a letter of the Deputy Secretary dated 14.07.2023, the Director of Health Services has asked the Superintendent of the Hospital to furnish details of the service and disbursement in respect of the deceased government officer.

Mr. Halder, learned counsel assures that on the next date of hearing further information as to the admissible dues accruing from the deceased employee will be presented before this Tribunal.

The matter is admitted.
