The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

With the consent of both the parties, matter has been taken up for hearing. .

The instant application has been filed praying for a direction upon the respondent authority for compassionate employment. The husband of the applicant was a govt. employee under West Bengal Police who died on 02.07.2014. Thereafter the applicant made an application for compassionate appointment on 14.10.2014. Thereafter, the proposal for compassionate appointment of the applicant was sent to Home & Hill Affairs Deptt. for recommending the case of the applicant and requesting the Govt. to issue approval order of appointment for the post of Group –D- on 15.07.2019.

Counsel for the applicant has prayed for a direction to the respondent for expeditious disposal of the case.

Counsel for the respondent has submitted a copy of the letter dated 14.03.2022 where it appears that the Police Dte. Has requested the Home and Hill Affairs Deptt. for consideration and disposal of the case.

The Court at this stage does not find any urgency to direct
