In this application, Debabrata Pal has prayed for direction to the respondents to reconsider his application for compassionate employment. The father of the applicant was a Krishi Prajukti Sahayak working at Joypur Block Seed Farm, Bankura. Soon after the death of the father of the applicant on 15.02.2010, the applicant applied for employment on compassionate ground.

The respondents after considering the application and rejected on the ground of non fulfilment of income criteria by attaching a financial statement showing income of the family of the deceased employee where the total income of the family is more than 90 % of the gross salary of the deceased employee. Therefore, the case was rejected.

The counsel for the applicant disputes the calculation and submits that the income shown in the statement is not correct and he also submits that his mother who is a teacher does not live with him. At present, the applicant does not have any regular employment and is living in difficult times.

Let there be a direction on the respondent No. 4, Director of Agriculture to consider the application of the applicant if freshly submitted and pass a reasoned order considering if the calculation shown is correct or not and also that his mother does not stay with him. The applicant is also directed to submit fresh application incorporating these issues before the

Respondent No. 4 and the same shall be considered by the respondents within a period of four months by passing a reasoned order and communicate to the applicant. The matter is disposed of.
