The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels and the learned Departmental representative for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The applicant has prayed for a direction to the respondent authorities to grant pensionary benefits as was granted to similarly circumstanced absorbee pensioners by Memo. 1606-FS dated 05.06.2017 in terms of this Tribunal's order dated 18.01.2022 in OA-860 of 2019.

The instant case has been filed basically praying for an extension of benefit of the order dated 16.08.2022, whereby certain employees were granted pensionary benefit as per the order of this Hon'ble Tribunal. As per the applicants, they are similarly circumstanced to the petitioners of the aforesaid order.

During the course of the hearing, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice the purpose, if the concerned authority
