The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the Notification No. 949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24th December, 2020 and 456-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 16th July, 2021 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985.

The matter was admitted on 19th April, 2021 when directions were issued to file reply and rejoinder and the matter was directed to appear under the heading “Reply/Rejoinder and Objection” on 2nd August, 2021. However, due to the pandemic situation, the matter has appeared today under the heading “Reply/Rejoinder and Objection”.

At the very outset, Mr. G.P. Banerjee, learned advocate for the State respondents referring to the prayer submits that the cut off marks of the written test and the result of the candidates with break up of marks have been published. Submission is OMR of the applicants have also published, which is evident from the order passed in the case of Shamim Hossain.

Mr. A.L. Basu, learned advocate for the Public Service Commission, West Bengal is of the same view. However, Mr. D. Chatterjee, learned advocate for the applicant submits that though the cut off marks of the written test and the break up of marks have been published, the OMR of the applicants is yet to be published.

I find that the only dispute remains with regard to the publication of OMR of the applicants.
