The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the notification no.949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24th December, 2020 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-Section (6) of Section 5 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

In this application, Abhi Hansda, the applicant, has prayed for several reliefs, the relevant portion of which is as under:

“ a) An order directing the respondent authorities, their agents, subordinates and successors especially the respondent no.2 herein to allow the application of the applicant forwarded by the respondent no.4 to the respondent no.3 for consideration by the respondent no.2, by giving the appointment to the applicant in the service under the respondent authority on the compassionate ground for the sudden death of the father of the applicant while in service.

b) An order directing the respondents, their agents, subordinates and successors to comply with the order dated 05.02.2018 passed by this Learned Tribunal in the earlier Original application being O.A. No. 787 of 2017 within a specific period.”

Heard Mr.S.Bera, learned advocate for the applicant and Mr.S.Ghosh, learned advocate for the State respondents. I find that earlier the applicant had

moved the Tribunal by filing an application, being OA-787 of 2017, which was disposed of on 5th February, 2018 by passing an order, the relevant portion of which is as under:

“Accordingly, we direct the Respondent No. 02 to consider the materials and documents in connection with the Application for compassionate appointment of the Applicant as forwarded by the Respondent No. 4 to the Respondent No.3 on February 08, 2016 within a period of twelve weeks from the date for communication of the order and the result of the same must be communicated to the Applicant within a period of two weeks thereafter.

The Original Application stands disposed of.”

Therefore, in view of the prayer ‘b’ of the application, the Director of Health Services, Swasthya Bhawan, Kolkata, the Respondent no. 2 is directed to implement the order dated 5th February, 2018 passed in OA-787 of 2017 (Abhi Hansda Vs. The State of West Bengal & Others) by considering the materials and documents in connection with the application for compassionate appointment of the applicant, as forwarded by the Chief Medical of Health, Paschim Midnapore, the respondent no. 4 to the Joint Director of Health Services (Personnel), West Bengal, Swasthya Bhawan, Kolkata, the respondent no. 3 on 8th February, 2016, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of the order downloaded from the Internet/website and the result of the same shall be communicated to the applicant within a period of two weeks thereafter. The application is disposed of.
