The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the notification no.949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24th December, 2020 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-Section (6) of Section 5 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

In this application, Dr. Arindam Roy, the applicant, has prayed for several reliefs, the relevant prayers are as under:

“ a) To pass an appropriate order directing the respondent authority to show cause as to why the impugned employment notice being Advt No R/HMO/78(1)/1/2019 dated 30.12.2019 should be quashed and/or set aside as the said notice has been issued by the respondent authority beyond its jurisdiction and contrary with the provision of West Bengal State Homeopathy Medical Service Act, 2002;

b) To pass a mandatory order directing the respondent authority to absorbed the applicant to the post of Homeopathic Medical Officer immediately as he has experience in Private/ Government health sector for last 12 years;”
