The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The prayer in this application is for a direction upon the respondent authorities to process the application of the applicant for an employment under compassionate ground. After the death of her father, Pankaj Sardar, a Constable on 18.03.2023, the applicant had furnished a representation praying for an employment under compassionate ground. Aparna Mitra, her sister has objected and refused to issue a NOC for her. For such employment the NOC from other family members are required to be submitted. The applicant has also prayed for a direction upon her sister Aparna Mitra, the respondent No. 4 to give NOC to the applicant for such employment.

Having heard the submissions of the learned counsels, it is the finding of this Tribunal that this application is inadmissible for the primary reason that the Tribunal cannot issue a direction upon the private respondent No.4 to issue the NOC in favour of the applicant who has applied for employment under compassionate ground. Absence of a NOC also makes the applicant ineligible for such employment.
