The applicant, Priyanka Das, in this OA has prayed for a direction to the respondents to consider her job as G.D.A. on compassionate ground. Her father Panchu Das died in harness on 18.01.2004 leaving behind his wife Smt. Bakul Rani Das and the applicant Priyanka Das who was only 12 years old at the time of death of her father.

It appears that after the death of deceased employee, Panchu Das, his wife Bakul Rani Das had applied for job on compassionate ground for herself. Based on her application, the respondent authority had called her for interview as well had asked her to submit certain relevant documents, but unfortunately, Bakul Rani Das, the mother of the applicant expired in this year 2022 without completing the employment process.

Now, in this OA, the applicant Priyanka Das, the daughter of the deceased employee is claiming employment on compassionate ground.

Learned advocate for the state Mrs. Agarwal submits that this application is not maintainable due to the fact that the applicant has not yet submitted any representation for compassionate employment before the authority.
