During the course of the hearing, the counsel for the applicant has drawn our attention to the letter dated 27.07.2019 (Annexure-G) issued by the Director of Health Services, West Bengal and has submitted that her client is ready to make a comprehensive representation along with the supporting documents before the concerned authority i.e. Principal, Calcutta National Medical College. It would suffice her purpose if the authority would be directed to consider her representation within a stipulated period of time and make payment thereof.

The counsel for the respondents have submitted that though they have no objection to consider the representation of the applicant, however, from the perusal of the letter dated 27.07.2019, it would be evident that the husband of the applicant was missing since February 1989 and the applicant had applied for disbursement of admissible service benefit on 29.03.2019 i.e. after more than thirty years. Therefore, for proper consideration of her claim supporting documents are required at the end of the respondents.

In view of the above, the applicant is at liberty to make a comprehensive representation along with the supporting documents in favour of her claim before the Principal, Calcutta National Medical College in terms of the letter dated 27.07.2019 and the said authority is directed to consider the claim of the applicant as per law and pass a reasoned and speaking order after granting a personal hearing to the applicant within a period of eight weeks from the date of
