It appears that after the death of the father of the applicant on 22.04.2014, the applicant applied for compassionate employment on 09.06.2014.

Mr. Dyutiman Banerjee, learned advocate for the applicant submits that the respondents are sitting on it since 2014 without any progress or intimation to the applicant. Therefore, the respondents may be directed to consider the application without further delay and offer him a compassionate employment.

Mr. Subit Kumar Mondal, learned advocate for the State respondents submits that the proposal for the employment could not be completed due to want of certain documents. Submission is that the applicant may be directed to cooperate with the respondents by submitting those documents at the earliest.

Having heard both the learned advocates, the case is disposed of by directing the applicant to supply the documents within a period of eight weeks before the concerned Respondent. If the supporting documents are submitted to the respondents within the stipulated period, and if they are in order, then the proposal for compassionate employment should be submitted to the higher authorities if eligible under law within a period of four weeks thereafter. Final decision on the application should be communicated to the applicant within two weeks.

Accordingly, the matter is disposed of.
