In this application, Susmita Chakraborty, the applicant has prayed for certain reliefs, the relevant portion of which is as under:

*A) An order directing the respondents, their agents, subordinates and successors, to pass necessary order of transfer in favour of the applicant by transferring her service from Chandipur PHC (Milky BPHC), Malda to Raiganj BPHC, Uttar Dinajpur against the post of SAMO.*

It appears that the applicant, residing in Uttar Dinajpur, was appointed as Senior Ayurvedic Medical Officer at SAD Milki, at Chandipur Primary Health Centre in Malda on 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2019. It has been stated that she has to travel a distance of 222 k.m. every day for attending her duty at Malda. It appears that the applicant is married to Dr. Nilanjan Kr.Das, who is working as Medical Officer at Raiganj Government Medical College and Hospital in the district of Uttar Dinajpur. She has a male child, mother-in-law and father-in-law to look after. As the applicant is facing serious difficulties, in view of the memo. dated 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2002, particularly clauses 4 and 5 thereof, she has filed an application on 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 praying for transfer to Uttar Dinajpur. Since the application for transfer has not been considered, representation dated 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 has been filed before the Director of Ayurveda, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of West
