The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No.496-WBAT / 1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6(5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

In the application, Dr. Anup Kumar Maity, the applicant, - who is working since 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2013 under the National Rural Health Mission, funded by the Central Government and appointed by the Pradhan, Bakhrrabad Gram Panchayat, - has prayed for a direction upon the respondents for permanent status without being affected by the provisions of the West Bengal State Homoeopathy Health Service Act, 2002.

Heard Mr. Arup Kumar Chatterjee, learned advocate for the applicant, Mr. Gautam Pathak Banerjee, learned advocate for the State respondents.

Since the applicant is working under National Rural Health Mission funded by the Central Government and appointment has been given by the Pradhan, Bakhrrabad Gram Panchayat and as the applicant is not concerned with "any civil service of the State" nor does he hold any "civil post" under the State as stipulated under section 15 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985, the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to entertain the application. Therefore, no order is passed on the application. The application is dismissed. However, this order will not prevent the applicant to move before the appropriate forum ventilating his grievances, if any, and if so advised.
