In this application, the applicants have prayed for a direction to the respondents to sanction their pension after condonation of shortfall in qualifying service. The learned advocate for the applicants refers to page 33 of the application in which on 08.01.2020, the Deputy Secretary (Technical), Department of Finance (Revenue) Deptt. had advised the I.G.R. & C.S.R., W.B. to submit a proposal with relevant documents for condonation of shortfall under Rule 36 of WBS(DCRB) Rules, 1971. The learned counsel submits that no such proposal has been submitted by the IGR & CSR to the Finance (Revenue) Deptt. till now and the applicant has also submitted a detailed representation dated 06.03.2019. Learned counsel submits that a direction may be given to the Respondent No. 5 to dispose of the representation mentioned above at the earliest.

After hearing, the learned advocates and considering the facts and circumstances, the application is disposed of by directing the Respondent No. 5, the Registrar of Assurances, Kolkata to dispose of the representation of the applicants dated 06.03.2019 and taking into consideration para

11, 12 & 14 of the Judgement passed in WPST-112 of 2019 by way of passing a reasoned order within a period of twelve weeks from the date of this order and also to communicate the same to the applicants within two weeks thereafter.
