In the instant application, Sanjay Bapari - the applicant, son of the deceased Ashok Bapari, Resham Karmi working in the office of the Amriti Graft Nursery, Directorate of Sericulture, Malda, has applied for compassionate employment. Ashok Bapari died in harness on 08.02.2019. Thereafter, the applicant made a representation on 21.06.2019 for consideration of an employment on compassionate ground.

The learned advocate on behalf of the applicant submits for issuing a direction to the concerned respondents to dispose of the application expeditiously.

The learned advocate representing the State submits that if such direction is given, the respondent will consider if eligible and whenever such vacancy occurs.

After having heard both the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the application is disposed of by directing the Director, Directorate of Sericulture, Government of West Bengal – the respondent no. 2 to dispose of the application by passing a reasoned order to be communicated to the parties within six months from the date
