In this application the applicant prays for a direction to the respondent for counting of his past services on and from 01.01.2001 to 01.01.2006 for Career Advancement Benefit.

Mrs. Agarwal submits that this application is not maintainable for the reason that the applicant has approached the Tribunal belatedly and as per existing rules, counting of past services for pension as well as Career Advancement Benefit are not admissible.

After hearing the applicant and Mrs. Agarwal, the application is disposed of by directing the respondent no. 3, Director of Technical Education, Govt. of West Bengal to examine and consider and pass a reasoned order on the subject matter after considering his representation and after giving an opportunity of hearing within a period of sixteen weeks. The reasoned order, so passed, can be communicated to the applicant within a period of two weeks thereafter.

Accordingly, OA is disposed of.
