Be it also be noted that in OA 280 of 2022, the applicant has prayed for family pension in which another wife, Mita Mondal (Rudra), private respondent No. has been receiving

the family pension. The fact that the deceased employee was married also to Mita Mandal (Rudra) be noted while passing the reasoned order.
