The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of counsel for both the parties, matter has been taken up for hearing.

The instant application has been filed mainly challenging the impugned final order dated 21.01.2021 whereby a punishment was imposed upon him with 20 % cut of pension for five years.

During the course of hearing the counsel for the applicant has submitted that the admissible portion of pension and pensionary benefits, however, has not been paid to the applicant till date. Therefore, he has prayed for payment of admissible portion of the pension and pensionary benefits. The counsel for the respondents has no objection to make payment admissible portion of retirement benefit as per rules.
