The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

In this application, Trisha Bhattacharya, the applicant, an Assistant Mistress in Economics, in New Integrated Government School, Jamboni (English Medium), has prayed for certain reliefs, the relevant portion of which is as under:

“ (a) An order do issue thereby directing the respondent authorities to transfer and allow posting to your applicant within home district i.e. South 24 Paraganas or Kolkata after considering the representations dated 16.09.2019 and 24.12.2019 within a stipulated time period.

“ (b) An order do issue thereby directing the respondent authorities to consider and dispose of the representation dated 16.09.2019 and 24.12.2019 by passing a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law after giving an opportunity of hearing and to communicate the decision thereof to your applicant within a stipulated time period.”

Relying on the application, it is submitted by Mr.M.N.Roy, learned advocate for the applicant that as the applicant has a three year old baby and has to commute 200 kilometres daily to reach Jamboni and has very old father-in-law and mother-in-law, and as representations dated 16th September, 2019 and 24th December, 2019 were furnished for transfer before the Commissioner, Directorate of School Education, Government of West Bengal, the respondent no. 2, appropriate order may be passed for consideration of the representations sympathetically and for posting the applicant in a nearby Government school having vacancy in the subject Economics.

Mr.S.K.Mondal, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the State respondents submits, if directed, the respondents will consider the matter for transferring the applicant in accordance with law.

Having heard the learned advocates for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the application is disposed of by directing the Commissioner of School Education, Directorate of School Education, Government of West Bengal, Kolkata, the respondent no. 2 to dispose of the representations dated 16th September, 2019 and 24th December, 2019 by passing a reasoned order to be communicated to the parties within eight weeks from the date of presentation of a copy of this order downloaded from the website of the Tribunal after giving an opportunity of hearing and after making an inquiry.
