The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of both the parties, matter has been taken up.

The instant application has been filed basically praying for extension of benefit of one order dated 17.07.2017 passed by the S.D.L & L.R.O. with regard to one judgement dated 16.02.2017 passed in OA-1046 of 2016, OA-1047 of 2016 and OA-1048 of 2016.

As per the applicants, they are similarly circumstanced with those petitioners and subsequently they made representation before the authority on 28.09.2018. However, till date no communication has been received by them from the respondents.

During the course of hearing, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice the purpose of the applicant if the Respondent No. 2 is directed to consider their representations and take appropriate steps accordingly.

The departmental representatives have no objection to consider the cases of the applicants after verifying individual cases.

In view of the above, the Respondent No. 2, A.D.M. & D.L. & L R O, South 24 Parganas is directed to consider the representations of the applicants dated 28.09.2018 treating the OA as a part of it and after verifying the individual cases of the applicants and granting
