The instant application has been filed by the wife of the deceased employee, who during his lifetime was inflicted in a criminal case. However, he died on 21.01.2019, but till date his family did not receive any death-cum-retirement benefit of the applicant as well as family pension.

As per the applicant, since the husband of the applicant had died and no punishment was imposed in his lifetime in the criminal case, therefore, the said criminal case has been abated. It has been further submitted that even no disciplinary proceeding is pending against the husband of the applicant. Therefore, it has been submitted by the counsel for the applicant that it would suffice her purpose if the S.P. , Baruipur, Police District be directed to consider the representation of the applicant and provide death-cum retirement benefit as per rules within a stipulated period of time.

The counsel for the applicant has further submitted that after the death of her husband, the applicant submitted representation before the S.P. Baruipur Police District on 13.01.2020 which was received by the office of the S.P. on 14.01.2020.

The counsel for the respondent has no objection to consider the representation of the applicant in accordance with law.

In view of the above, S.P. Baruipur Police district, Respondent No. 2 is directed to consider the representation of the applicant dated 13.01.2020 treating the OA as a part of it and to pass a reasoned and speaking order with follow up action after giving an opportunity of personal hearing to the

applicant as per rules within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of the order. Accordingly, OA is disposed of with no order as to costs.
