In this application, the applicant Sujay Kumar Biswas has applied for a job under compassionate ground after the death of the father who died in harness on 15.08.2011. Within a couple of months, the applicant applied for a job on compassionate ground in prescribed proforma. An enquiry committee which was set up by the respondents also recommended the claim for employment of the applicant.

After considering the application and all the documents, the respondents rejected the application on the ground that the applicant is only Class-VII appeared, hence as per W.B.S. (Group-D) Recruitment Rules, 2009 he is not eligible for appointment.

It appears that in the proforma application filled up by the applicant, educational qualification has been shown as Class-VII passed. The certificate issued by his school signed by the Headmaster that he was reading in Class VIII during 2002-2003. Since as per the guideline, minimum educational qualification for Group-D is Class VIII passed, thus not being satisfied, the respondents considered and rejected his application.

Let the matter be listed for hearing on **27.07.2022**.
