The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

At the very outset, Mr. S.N. Ray, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the applicant submits that though Tribunal by order dated 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2013 passed in OA 1272 of 2012 (Nipa Chatterjee – Vs- State of West Bengal & Ors) had granted leave to the applicant to submit an application for compassionate appointment in the prescribed form and as the applicant by mistake did not submit the same which is one of the reasons for rejection by order dated 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2017, leave may be granted to withdraw the instant application to enable the applicant to file application afresh in the prescribed proforma.

In view of the submission made by Mr. Ray, the application is withdrawn as dismissed with leave granted to the applicant to file an application for compassionate appointment in the prescribed form in accordance with the direction contained in the order dated 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2013
