The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Mr. Banerjee, learned counsel for the State respondents files copies of memo. no. 149 dated 17.06.2025 and memo. no. 150 dated 18.06.2025. Let the same be kept on record.

The memo no. 149 dated 17.06.2025 is a report relating to the legal heirs of deceased Constable, Bimal Murmu of Kolkata Police. The memo no. 150 dated 18.06.2025 is a statement from the Superintendent of Police, Paschim Medinipur that no criminal antecedents have been found and no FIR has been lodged against the applicant and his family members.

The applicant has filed this application praying for a direction to the respondent authorities to release arrear pension and GPF of the deceased employee. Since from the above report, it is clear that the legal heirs including this applicant is entitled to receive the GPF amount, a direction is given to the respondent no. 3, the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Reserve Force, Kolkata is directed to arrange and release of the GPF amount to the applicants.

With the above direction, this application is **disposed of**.
