Agarwal, learned advocate for the applicant is that the Finance Department memo. no. 1033-F(P₂) dated Howrah, the 8th February, 2019 allows giving enhanced remuneration to different kinds of casual and daily rated and contractual workers. Submission is that her applicant may also be given the benefit of this memorandum.

Mrs. S. Bandyopadhyay, learned advocate for the State respondents submits that the applicant does not belong to any of the category mentioned in the memorandum. The applicant is a part-time water supplier and sweeper in the office and gets remuneration as entitled to her.

Mrs. Agarwal states that it will suffice if a direction is given to the respondent to consider her representation submitted to the Additional D. I. of Schools (S.E), Gangarampur Sub-Division, Dakshin Dinajpur.

Having heard learned advocates, the matter is disposed of by
