The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.- II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

By presenting a copy of the reasoned order passed on 23.07.2024 by the Secretary and Controller of Examinations, Mr. Banerjee submits that the direction this Tribunal has been complied. However, Mr. Sen, learned counsel for the applicant is not satisfied with the outcome of the reasoned order. His submission is that the Tribunal's direction to examine his original D.C.I Registration Certificate renewed up to 31.12.2024 be examined was not complied and no opportunity given to appear before the Interview Board.

Having examined this reasoned order, the Tribunal has come to understand that the Secretary and Controller of Examinations had examined the original DCI Registration Certificate of the applicant as evident from 7 paragraph of page 2 of the reasoned order. It is another matter that after such examination of the document, the respondent authority was not satisfied and did not allow the applicant to appear for the interview.

Since no further direction is required to be given, the application is disposed of without passing any orders.
