In this application, the applicant, Sumangal Mondal retired as Cook-cum-Chowkidar from Memari Irrigation Sub Division. Earlier he had worked as a Khalasi and later promoted to this post. The office of the Executive Engineer referred the matter to the Department for giving post facto approval to the applicant's promotion as Cook-cum-Chowkidar from Khalasi as submitted by Mr. M.N. Roy. Such post facto approval has not yet been received. In the meantime, the applicant retired from service on 30.06.2017 and so far he has not received any pension and other retiral benefits. He has also submitted that several representations but has not received any action so far. In his representation he has also prayed that in case such post facto approval is not forthcoming, let his services be reverted back to Khalasi.

Mr. S.N. Roy, learned advocate for the respondent submits that if directed suitable action will be taken from the end of the respondents to release his pension and other retiral benefits expeditiously.

Having heard the learned advocates of both the sides and considering the records, the respondent No. 1, Principal Secretary, I & W D Department, Jalsampad Bhawan, Salt Lake is
