Mr.G.P.Banerjee, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the State respondents submits that as the applicant is yet to receive the information regarding said breakup, as there is an effective alternative remedy she is at liberty to prefer appeal under section 19 of the 2005 Act and hence the application is not maintainable.
