The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The applicant has prayed for a direction to revise his pension on the basis of pay of Rs. 14,730/- + Grade Pay Rs. 3,900/- and thus fix the pension @ Rs. 9,265/-. The applicant also prays for the benefit of ROPA 2019.

Attention is drawn to page 21 of this application which appears to be a communication made by the Office of the Principal Accountant General to the Superintendent of Police, Hooghly. In this correspondence, the Principal Accountant General clearly states that the last pay of the applicant as on 29.02.2012 was fixed at Rs. 18,090/- (including GP of Rs. 3900/-) and his pensionary benefits have been fixed and released accordingly. The communication also makes it clear that there is no need for revision of pension of this applicant.

After hearing the submissions of the learned counsels, the Tribunal finds that this matter for revision of his pension was earlier examined and
