In this application, the applicant prays for a direction to consider his application for compassionate employment. The applicant's father was a constable with Midnapore Police, Paschim Midnapore who died in harness on 30.07.2010. Soon after the father's death, the applicant applied for employment under died in harness category by submitting an application before the respondent authority on 02.02.2011. Despite several representations, no response was forth coming regarding his application for compassionate appointment, thus he moved the Tribunal for redressal.

The counsel for the applicant submits that earlier in OA-857 of 2015 the applicant had approached before the Tribunal and the Tribunal was pleased to direct the respondents to dispose of the application within a period of four weeks.

In pursuance of the direction of the Tribunal, the respondents on 23.12.2015 considered and ordered that :-

“Considering the fact, as discussed hereinbefore in details, that the proposals are processed in this department in serials according to date of death of deceased employees

and there is presently a wide gap between his serial number and number of vacancy for the post of LDC, I am of the considered opinion that the term of Chayan Mukherjee has not yet come for processing of the proposal of the D.G.& I.G. of Police, West Bengal. His application for compassionate appointment for the post of LDC. It will be processed when his serial number under unreserved category will come within the number of vacant post for the post of LDC under unreserved category for exempted category employment.”

Mr. G.P. Banerjee, learned advocate appearing on behalf of Mr. M.N. Roy prays for an accommodation. Let the matter be listed for Order on **15.09.2022**.
